COVID Precautions and Expectations

As we continue our band season, the band staff and school district are closely monitoring the constantly evolving COVID-19 pandemic. As we have in the past, we will strictly adhere to policies and procedures as set forth by LISD and TEA. We do strongly recommend vaccination for our students as a means to help ensure their ability to have uninterrupted participation in our band program throughout the semester. Vaccination is one way we can help prevent student guarantines, which will be important to a successful performance season.

The band staff will also utilize the following additional precautions and expectations:

- LISD recommends wearing masks when indoors. The band staff will adapt the speed of teaching as needed for students who are utilizing masks during rehearsals. Playing masks WILL be allowed during rehearsal as long as the district recommendation is in place. While we are not providing playing masks, we can assist students with how to turn a disposable surgical mask into a playing mask if needed. Mask wearing is currently recommended and as with all things, students will be accepted and supported with whatever choice their family has made regarding mask wearing.
- The band staff asks that students NOT attend rehearsal if they are experiencing COVID symptoms. Many of our students are active for the first time in a while, and it will be important to discriminate between COVID symptoms and physical fatigue due to exercise.
- The sharing of water jugs, food, etc. is absolutely prohibited and will be monitored.
- The band staff will work through district administration, when needed, for contact tracing, guarantines, etc. We will follow district guidelines and expectations to ensure the safety of our students.

As we move forward, we will continue to be flexible and prepared for adjustments to our processes. If we've learned anything this year, it's how to adapt. We are committed to providing an exceptional experience for our students, while working within the guidelines of the district and state.

Attendance

Attendance is required at summer rehearsals. The band staff will utilize attendance, spring auditions, show music passoff's and visual performance to determine decisions regarding Varsity and Non-Varsity marching positions.
