<u>Alamodome Site Information for Spectators</u>

- Parking for Friday BOA NOTE on Friday, spectator parking is NOT available onsite due to COVID Vaccinations in Lot B. Please utilize nearby lots offsite. There are numerous public parking lots west of I-37 in the vicinity of the Convention Center.
- Parking for Saturday BOA & UIL SMC A limited amount of spectator parking will be available adjacent to the Alamodome in LOT B (instead of the usual LOT C). Due to an unavoidable Covid-19 vaccination station in LOT B, it is likely that this lot will fill up at some point during the day, especially on Monday. Once this lot is full spectators must find parking elsewhere. There are numerous public parking lots west of I-37 in the vicinity of the Convention Center. The spectator parking rate for LOT B is \$15.00 and is subject to change. There are no in and out privileges.

Spending Money

Schedule

Keep a copy of the itinerary with you or on your phone at all times. Be punctual...to be early is to be on time. It is not fair to the rest of the group to wait for you. Failure to adhere to the itinerary will result in disciplinary action.

Prescription Medication

If your student requires an adult to administer prescription medication, there will be a medication check-in on Saturday in the **Band Hall at 9:00 am**. Please include the attached form and place the form and medication in zip-loc bag. The medication will be collected and logged as you turn it in. Look for the "Prescription Medication" table in the band hall. All prescription medication must include the appropriate LISD form and should only include the amount of medication (in its original container) that is needed for this trip.

Security

Most of you will be carrying money and valuables. Be aware that these items can sometimes "disappear" at any time. Be smart...do not leave luggage, purses, phones, bags, etc. in an unsecured area.

Respect of Adults

Directors, chaperones, hotel personnel, and Alamodome staff are to be treated with the utmost respect at all times. These adults are present to help you to have a fun and safe trip. They ARE NOT present to "wait on you." Be polite and respectful at all times. Please follow instructions the first time they are given.

Chaperone "check-in"

Each room will be assigned a chaperone. There will be times during the trip when you will be expected to check in with your assigned chaperone. Any indicated chaperone check-in is absolutely mandatory.

Relationships

Public Displays of Affection are strictly prohibited at all times, in all places, when traveling with the Vandegrift Band and Vision Dance Company. Repeated violations will be handled appropriately.

Groups

You must stay in groups of three or more throughout the duration of the trip. This includes the hotel property, meals, and the Alamodome. NEVER go off alone.

Citizenship

Remember that you are representing yourself, your family, Leander ISD, Vandegrift High School and the Vandegrift Band Program. Your behavior should reflect this...at all times.

<u>Illness</u>

Please report to a chaperone quickly if you ever feel ill.

<u>Sleep</u>

This is a **Performance** Trip, and you must be well rested to perform well. When given the opportunity, it is crucial for you to get as much rest as possible. "Lights out" means just that.

Overnight Trip Rules – San Antonio Super Regional/UIL State Marching Contest 2021

- 1. There will be no boys in girls' rooms or girls in boys' rooms for any reason, unless in the presence of a band director or chaperone. Any student violating this rule will be sent home at the expense of their parents.
- 2. Students will not be out of their rooms after curfew unless accompanied by an adult chaperone or designated school sponsor. Students will be given a chaperone's phone number to call in case of an emergency. Any student in violation of this policy will be sent home at the expense of their parents.
- 3. The possession or use of any tobacco product, alcohol product, chemicals, inhalants, intoxicants, electronic cigarettes or mood-altering drugs is strictly prohibited. Any student violating this policy will be sent home at the expense of their parents and referred to his/her campus administrator.
- 4. Any property damage will be paid for by the student(s) responsible for the damage.
- 5. Students are not to leave an assigned area for any reason or get into any vehicle other than school designated transportation.
- 6. Any student in violation of local, state, or federal laws will be turned over to law enforcement authorities. If the student returns to the group, he/she will be sent home at the expense of their parents.
- 7. Any student who excessively violates any trip guidelines may be sent home at the expense of their parents.
- 8. Student will follow all policies set forth in the Vandegrift High School Band Handbook.
- 9. If a student is sent home for any reason, the parent/guardian agrees to pay the full cost of the student's return trip to Austin. The parent/guardian will provide appropriate information (credit card number, etc.) to school district personnel in order that appropriate return transportation may be purchased.
- 10. A student being sent home from a trip will result in permanent removal from the Vandegrift Band and Vision Program.

Hotel Guidelines
