<u>Meals</u>

All meals will either be provided for the students or a meal per diem will be given to cover meals when they are with their chaperone groups.

Luggage Restrictions

Students will be spending five nights in New York City in November. Please pack conservatively but do make plans to <u>dress warm</u>. Students should bring layers (compression/heat wear, thermal underwear, etc.) to wear under their uniform and while walking around New York City.

Each student is allowed one checked bag. Checked bags must not exceed 62" in overall dimensions (length x width x height) and cannot exceed 50 pounds. Each student may also bring one carry-on item plus one personal item (purse, backpack, etc.). Your carry-on must not exceed 24"L x 16"W x 10"H. Your personal item must be able to fit under the seat in front of you. Be sure that all luggage (including carry-on) is clearly marked with your name, address, and phone number.

What to Pack...reminders

- 1. Cell Phone and charger (portable chargers are encouraged as well)
- 2. Back Packs and small bags (band duffle if you have one)
- 3. All Uniform Accessories
- 4. All instrument Accessories
- 5. Band Water Jug
- 6. Toiletries
- 7. Warm clothes (be prepared to dress in layers)
 - a. Jacket
 - b. Sweatshirt
 - c. Under garments (thermal underwear, compression leggings, etc.) to be worn under the uniform during the parade. All students **MUST** bring a top and bottom layer.
 - d. Hand/Feet warmers
 - e. Gloves
 - f. Scarf
 - g. Hat

Schedule

Always keep a copy of the itinerary with you. Be punctual...to be early is to be on time. It is not fair to the rest of the group to wait for you. Failure to adhere to the itinerary will result in disciplinary action.

Security

Most of you will be carrying money and valuables. Be aware that these items can sometimes "disappear" at any time. Be smart...do not leave luggage, purses, cameras, bags, horn cases, etc. in an unsecured area.

Respect of Adults

Directors, chaperones, hotel personnel, and park staff are to be always treated with the utmost respect. These adults are present to help you to have a fun and safe trip. They ARE NOT present to "wait on you." Be always polite and respectful. Please follow instructions the first time they are given.

Chaperone Groups

Students will spend most travel times with their chaperone groups. This is not optional, and students will be expected to follow directions from their chaperones while traveling on the subway or walking down streets in NYC.

Relationships

Public Displays of Affection are strictly prohibited at all times, in all places, when traveling with the Vandegrift Band and Vision Dance Company. Repeated violations will be handled appropriately.

Groups

Your primary travel companions will be your room and chaperone groups. You must stay in groups of three or more throughout the duration of the trip. This includes the hotel property, meals, and while walking around New York City. NEVER go off alone. Any student found alone will be disciplined appropriately.

Citizenship

Remember that you are representing yourself, your family, Leander ISD, Vandegrift High School and the Vandegrift Band Program. Your behavior should reflect this. All future band trips depend upon what happens on this trip.

Illness

Please report to a chaperone quickly if you ever feel ill.

Medicine

If you take prescription medication, it must be kept with the assigned chaperone.

Sleep

This is a **Performance** Trip, and you must be well rested to perform well. When given the opportunity, it is crucial for you to get as much rest as possible. "Lights out" means just that.

Prescription Medication

If your student requires an adult to administer prescription medication, there will be a medication check-in at the band hall on <u>Saturday</u>, <u>November 19 at 11:30 AM</u>. Please include the attached, district approved form and place the form and medication in zip-loc bag. The medication will be collected and logged as you turn it in. Look for the "Prescription Medication" table in the band hall. Prescription medication will only be handled and dispersed by staff members and LISD approved medical chaperones.

Notes Regarding Medication Form

As a reminder, the Prescription Medication Authorization Form requires a physician's signature for each medication. The medication must be in its original bottle and cannot be expired. A separate form must be submitted for each medication. Please note that we already have Over the Counter (OTC) Authorization Forms for each student; these were received at Band Registration.

Overnight Trip Rules – Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade Trip 2022

- 1. There will be no boys in girls' rooms or girls in boys' rooms for any reason, unless in the presence of a band director or chaperone. Any student violating this rule will be sent home at the expense of their parents.
- 2. Students will not be out of their rooms after curfew unless accompanied by an adult chaperone or designated school sponsor. Students will be given a chaperone's phone number to call in case of an emergency. Any student in violation of this policy will be sent home at the expense of their parents.
- 3. The possession or use of any tobacco product, alcohol product, or illegal substance is strictly prohibited. Any student violating this policy will be sent home at the expense of their parents and referred to his/her campus administrator. Violation will result in immediate removal from the Band and Vision Program.
- 4. Any property damage will be paid for by the student(s) responsible for the damage.
- 5. Students are not to leave an assigned area for any reason or get into any vehicle other than school designated transportation.
- 6. Any student in violation of local, state, or federal laws will be turned over to law enforcement authorities. If the student returns to the group, he/she will be sent home at the expense of their parents.
- 7. Any student who excessively violates any trip guidelines will be sent home at the expense of their parents.
- 8. If a student is sent home for any reason, the parent/guardian agrees to pay the full cost of the student's return trip to Austin. The parent/guardian will provide appropriate information (credit card number, etc.) to school district personnel so that appropriate return transportation may be purchased.
- 9. Student will follow all policies set forth in the Vandegrift High School Band and Vision Handbook.
- 10. Violation of any of these rules may result in permanent removal from the Vandegrift Band and Vision Program.

Hotel Guidelines

- 1. Keep your room neat and clean at all times
- 2. No movies/room service will be available
- 3. Chaperones can and will enter rooms at any time for inspections
- 4. Any suspicious activity will be investigated immediately
- 5. Curfew will be strictly enforced
- 6. The hotel will have many other guests...be courteous and quiet when not in your room
- 7. Never congregate in the halls
